Note on significant changes in shareholders' equity

During the first quarter of the current consolidated accounting period, capital surplus increased by 1,081 million yen due to changes in the parent company's equity due to the conversion of class shares of Kabushiki Kaisha GI Holdings a consolidated subsidiary of the Company, to common shares.

Adoption of accounting treatment specific to the preparation of quarterly consolidated financial statements

(Calculation of tax expenses)

Tax expenses for certain consolidated subsidiaries of the Company were calculated by multiplying profit before income taxes by the estimated effective tax rates. The tax rate was determined by making a reasonable estimate of the effective tax rate after the adoption of tax effect accounting for profit before income taxes in the fiscal year including the first quarter ended June 30, 2021.

Changes in accounting policies

(Application of "Accounting Standard for Revenue Recognition")

The Accounting Standard for Revenue Recognition" (ASBJ Statement No. 29, March 31, 2020), hereinafter, Revenue Recognition Accounting Standards, was applied from the beginning of the first quarter consolidated accounting period and when control of a promised goods or service is transferred to the customer, we will recognize revenue in the amount expected to be received in exchange for the goods or service. As a result, for some transactions, the total amount of consideration received from customers was previously recognized as revenue. For transactions in which the Group's role in providing goods or services to customers is as an agent, revenue is recognized as a net amount obtained by deducting the amount paid to the supplier from the amount received from the customer.

The application of the Revenue Recognition Accounting Standard follows the treatment stipulated in Section 84 of the Revenue Recognition Accounting Standard, and the impact of retroactively applying the new accounting policy prior to the beginning of the first quarter consolidated accounting period has been adjusted from retained earnings at the beginning of the first quarter consolidated accounting period. The new accounting policy is applied from the balance at the beginning of the period. As a result, net sales and cost of sales for the first quarter of the current consolidated fiscal year decreased by 34,782 million yen. Additionally, there is no effect on the beginning balance of retained earnings.

(Application of "Accounting Standard for Fair Value Measurement")

The "Accounting Standard for Fair Value Measurement" (ASBJ Statement No. 30, July 4, 2019, hereinafter referred to as "Fair Value Measurement Accounting Standard") was applied from the beginning of the first quarter consolidated accounting period and in accordance with the transitional treatment stipulated in Section 19 of "Fair Value Measurement Accounting Standard" and Section 44-2 of Accounting Standard for Financial Instruments (ASBJ Statement No. 10 July 4, 2019), we have decided to apply the new accounting policy stipulated by the "Fair Value Measurement Accounting Standard" in the future. As a result, for other securities whose fair value is the balance sheet value,

the price was previously calculated based on the average market price for the month before the end of the fiscal year, but the method has been changed to use the market price at the end of the fiscal year.
