1. Reason for the amendment

After the release of the News Release regarding Google Pay, ACOM CO., LTD. finds a correction and announces a partial amendment.

2. Details of the amendment

(Deletion of Description)

- Delete the statement regarding "MasterCard merchants accepting tap-to-pay."
- Delete the statement regarding "reload Suica cards."
- Delete the statement regarding "entering shipping address and contact."

(Addition of Description)

- Add the condition "when using Google Pay in a store." to the statement that "since the merchant will never know customer's credit card number."

It also enables customers to make purchases in apps and online. Customers can easily set their “AC MasterCard”, and automatic cash back when using “AC MasterCard” will also continue to apply.

- About Google Pay

Google Pay is a contactless mobile payment services that can be used with Android smartphones. By adding credit card or other payment methods, customers can make payments with their smartphone. The same security technology as Google's other services is used to protect their account and data, so customers can use this payment method safely and securely.

Google Pay is accepted at QUICPay merchants (terminals) in Japan only across convenience stores, supermarkets, drugstores, large theme parks and more with the device that support Osaifu-Keitai (wallet application) 6.1.5 or higher, and Android™ 5.0 or higher.

Customers can also use Google Pay for online payments in the app or on the web. Payments can be completed with just a few clicks on the web, and there is no need to enter credit card numbers each time customers make a purchase. It's quick and easy, and very secure and private, since the merchant will never know customer's credit card number when using Google Pay in a store.
