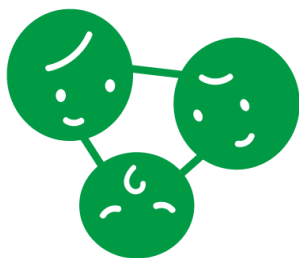

Risk Assessment AI Evaluation System for Children in Need of Support
Received Award of Excellence in Childcare ICT Division, BabyTech® Awards

(Head office: Shibuya-ku, Tokyo, Representative Director and President: Takuma Yamamoto, referred to below as “the Company”) was selected for the Award of Excellence in the Childcare ICT Division for its risk assessment AI evaluation system for children in need of support (referred to below as “the system”) that uses the Company’s proprietary AI at BabyTech® Awards 2022, a contest organized by Papasmile (Address: Chiyoda-ku, Tokyo, Representative Director: Tetsuya Nagata) to recognize outstanding childcare IT products, services, and appliances.

The Company will make further contributions by reflecting Kanamic cloud services and the expertise cultivated through the Ministry of Internal Affairs and Communication’s regional IOT implementation project adopted in fiscal 2019 in the diffusion and promotion of AI, IoT, and big data in the field of parenting as well as the PHR model aimed at support by local governments for safe and secure child rearing.

■Details of the system

Early detection and response by local governments are key factors in the prevention of child abuse in parenting support. In many cases, local government staff members make comprehensive assessments of child abuse risks by checking consultation and support records visually from a vast number of consultations and judging case situations based on staff experience. By operating with human resources alone, there is a concern that small risks or risks that could become serious in the future will be overlooked.

Using the system, the risk factors and risk levels in the "Common Risk Assessment Tool for Child Abuse for Child Guidance Centers and Municipalities" published by the Ministry of Health, Labour and Welfare can be automatically determined using AI. Furthermore, by utilizing the basic AI data, in addition to the results evaluated by the AI based on the recorded information of each municipality, it is possible to grow the teacher data in accordance with the circumstances of each local government by feeding the results of assessment by local government staff members back into the system.

■Other

(1) BabyTech® Awards

The BabyTech® Awards is an event that recognizes baby tech products and services and childcare appliances distributed in Japan. It was held for the first time in Japan in 2019 by Papasmile. In 2022, the fourth year of the event, the name was changed to BabyTech® Awards 2022, awards that are not limited to Japan, following discussions with the organization that holds the rights to Baby Tech Awards in the U.S., with a view to developing the global baby tech market.
