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1. Overview of Operating Results and Financial Position

(1) Overview of Operating Results

The Group has made efforts to enhance corporate value over the mid to long term by working to form an earnings base on the two approaches of working to entertain and to serve and by evolving into a new kind of tech company, including encouraging synergy between the two approaches. The Group has also been working to establish an even stronger business portfolio.

During the six months ended September 30, 2022 (from April 1, 2022 to September 30, 2022), revenue was \pm 71,223 million, up 4.6% year-on-year. While revenue decreased year-on-year in the Game Business, the Sports Business recovered and the Live Streaming Business grew.

Cost of sales was ¥35,834 million, up 11.6% year-on-year. In addition to an increase in commission fees, which fluctuate in line with the performance of the Live Streaming Business and the Game Business, etc., personnel expenses increased due to the release of new game titles since the six months ended September 30, 2021. In addition, expenses for the recovery of the Sports Business and new consolidation of DATA HORIZON CO., LTD. increased.

Selling, general and administrative expenses were \(\frac{\pmax}{2}\)8.817 million, up 2.0% year-on-year. Sales promotion expenses and advertising expenses increased primarily for the Live Streaming Business, while commission fees declined, reflecting the performance of the Game Business.

Other income, net was ¥505 million, compared to ¥5,605 million for the same period of the previous fiscal year. In the same period of the previous fiscal year, other income included a gain on step acquisitions due to the acquisition of all the shares of IRIAM Inc., as well as compensation for loss mainly due to the suspension of operations of the Yokohama DeNA BayStars Baseball Club, Inc.

Share of profit of associates accounted for using the equity method was ¥604 million, down 95.1% year-on-year. The main factors of the year-on-year fluctuation included the performance trends of Cygames, Inc., a major associate accounted for using the equity method, as well as the recording of a one-time gain from the capital increase of Mobility Technologies Co., Ltd. through a third-party allotment in the same period of the previous fiscal year.

As a result, revenue of the DeNA Group was \(\frac{\pmathrm{47,023}}{1,223}\) million, up 4.6% year-on-year, operating profit was \(\frac{\pmathrm{47,076}}{1,300}\) million, down 47.0% year-on-year, profit before tax was \(\frac{\pmathrm{416,347}}{1,090}\) million, down 41.3% year-on-year, and profit for the period attributable to owners of the parent was \(\frac{\pmathrm{411,090}}{1,090}\) million, down 51.1% year-on-year.

Business performance by segment is as follows.

Further, from the six months ended September 30, 2022, the segment previously reported as the "Healthcare Business" has been changed to the "Healthcare & Medical Business."

1) Game Business

Revenue of the Game Business was \(\frac{\pma}{3}\)2,700 million, down 15.7% year-on-year, and segment profit was \(\frac{\pma}{4}\),014 million, down 37.3% year-on-year.

During the six months ended September 30, 2022, both revenue and profit decreased as operations were centered on existing titles and virtual currency consumption decreased year-on-year. To strengthen the earnings base, in addition to the release of new titles, the Company continues to strive to make the cost structure more robust and optimize fixed costs.

2) Live Streaming Business

Revenue of the Live Streaming Business was ¥19,590 million, up 17.0% year-on-year, and segment loss was ¥358 million, compared with segment profit of ¥2,888 million for the same period of the previous fiscal year.

During the six months ended September 30, 2022, Pococha continued to perform solidly in Japan. In addition, the global Pococha service as well as the anime character live streaming service IRIAM saw good usage trends. The Company made proactive growth investments in these areas.

3) Sports Business

Revenue of the Sports Business was ¥15,800 million, up 67.4% year-on-year, and segment profit was ¥4,614 million, up 559.3% year-on-year.

Although the current situation still requires close attention to COVID-19 trends, the performance of the Sports Business recovered significantly compared to the same period of the previous fiscal year, during which the number of spectators had to be restricted.

4) Healthcare & Medical Business

Revenue of the Healthcare & Medical Business was ¥1,811 million, up 68.5% year-on-year, and segment loss was ¥912 million, compared with segment loss of ¥534 million for the same period of the previous fiscal year.

During the six months ended September 30, 2022, the performance of "kencom" and other related businesses in the healthcare service field was solid. The Company also made progress in strategic initiatives for medium- to long-term growth, including M&A. Of these, DATA HORIZON CO., LTD. became a consolidated subsidiary of the Company on August 3, 2022.

5) New Businesses and Others

Revenue of the New Businesses and Others was ¥1,360 million, down 33.7% year-on-year, and segment loss was ¥369 million, compared with segment loss of ¥116 million for the same period of the previous fiscal year.

This section comprises various initiatives that aim to reinforce the Group's business portfolio over the mid to long term as well as services of the E-commerce Business, etc.

(2) Overview of Financial Position and Cash Flows

1) Financial Position

Total assets at the end of the six months ended September 30, 2022 were \(\frac{\pma}{3}\)52,271 million, an increase of \(\frac{\pma}{1}\)1,702 million compared to the end of the previous fiscal year.

Current assets were \(\frac{\pmathbf{4}}{137,077}\) million, an increase of \(\frac{\pmathbf{2}}{26,657}\) million compared to the end of the previous fiscal year. This was due mainly to an increase in cash and cash equivalents by \(\frac{\pmathbf{3}}{32,896}\) million.

Non-current assets were \(\frac{\text{\$\text{\$\geq}}}{215,194}\) million, representing a decrease of \(\frac{\text{\$\geq}}{14,955}\) million compared to the end of the previous fiscal year. This was due mainly to a decrease in other non-current financial assets by \(\frac{\text{\$\geq}}{53,183}\) million and an increase in investments accounted for using the equity method by \(\frac{\text{\$\geq}}{25,329}\) million.

Total liabilities at the end of the six months ended September 30, 2022 amounted to \(\frac{1}{4}107,454\) million, an increase of \(\frac{1}{4}11,791\) million compared to the end of the previous fiscal year.

Current liabilities were \(\frac{\pmathbf{Y77,356}}{17,356}\) million, representing an increase of \(\frac{\pmathbf{Y21,331}}{21,331}\) million compared to the end of the previous fiscal year. This was due mainly to an increase in borrowings by \(\frac{\pmathbf{Y16,300}}{16,300}\) million.

Non-current liabilities stood at ¥30,098 million, representing a decrease of ¥9,540 million compared to the end of the previous fiscal year. This was due mainly to a decrease of ¥9,323 million in deferred tax liabilities.

Total equity at the end of the six months ended September 30, 2022 was \(\frac{4}{244,818}\) million, representing a decrease of \(\frac{4}{89}\) million compared to the end of the previous fiscal year. (7) Notes to Condensed Consolidated Financial Statements

1. Segment information

1) Outline of reportable segments

The Group principally provides Internet services for mobile and PC users and organizes business divisions by type of service. Each of these business divisions formulates comprehensive business strategies for the services it provides, and undertakes related business activities.

Therefore, the Group is composed of operating segments classified by the types of services provided. The four reportable segments of the Group are classified as the "Game Business," "Live Streaming Business," "Sports Business" and "Healthcare & Medical Business."

Effective from the six months ended September 30, 2022, the name of the reportable segment that was previously "Healthcare Business" has been changed to "Healthcare & Medical Business." This change is a change in the name of the reportable segment and has no impact on segment information. Segment information for the six months ended September 30, 2021 is also presented under the new name.

The types of services provided by each segment classification are shown in the table below:

1) Overview of the share acquisition

The Company passed a resolution at a meeting of the Board of Directors held on August 24, 2022, to conduct share delivery whereby the Company became a share delivery parent company while Allm Inc. ("Allm") became a share delivery subsidiary company, and thereafter has been engaged in preparation of a share delivery plan. On October 3, 2022, the share delivery took effect whereby Allm became a consolidated subsidiary of the Company on the same date.

Allm had been the Company's associate accounted for using the equity method since July 2022.
