## Notice Concerning the Obtaining of SBT Accreditation for GHG Emission Reduction Targets

Keihanshin Building Co., Ltd. (the "Company") hereby announces that it has obtained the "Science Based Targets" accreditation ("SBT," which are emission reduction targets with a scientific basis) for the greenhouse gas (GHG) emission reduction targets it has established for 2030.

## 1. Overview of SBT

Science Based Targets (SBT refer to GHG emission reduction targets established by corporations for the next 5 to 15 years, in compliance with the standards set out in the Paris Agreement (to limit global warming to well below 2, preferably to 1.5 degrees Celsius, compared to pre-industrial levels). SBTi is an international initiative jointly operated by four organizations: CDP, United Nations Global Compact (UNGC), World Resources Institute (WRI), and the World Wildlife Fund (WWF). It accredits corporations that have established SBT targets.

The Company has obtained SBT accreditation for establishing targets for reducing GHG emissions by FY2030, and ensuring that these targets are based on science and compliant with the standards set out in the Paris Agreement.
