Please note that some of the image data lost may contain personal data. However, it has not been leaked to external parties, but lost. The server program with a bug is already halted, and the Livedoor Blog service is running without any disruptions. Moving forward, we will strive to enhance security and ensure thorough data management across our group of companies. Please refer to the attached document for further details regarding this matter.

The impact of this matter on the consolidated performance is currently expected to be minimal. Further announcements will be made promptly in case the Company sees material impacts in the future.

## **Notice Regarding the Loss of Image Data in Livedoor Blog**

livedoor Co., Ltd. (hereinafter “the Company”, Chiyoda-ku, President and COO: Naohito Miyamoto) regret to inform you that a portion of the image data associated with Livedoor Blog, our service, has been lost due to a malfunction in the image data management server program. We deeply apologize for the inconvenience and concern caused to our valued users.

Regarding this matter, the Company have taken steps to halt the program responsible for the issue on the image data management server. Furthermore, there has been no leakage of personal data.

Please find below the details concerning this incident:

### 1.Event Occurrence:

An incident occurred in the image data storage server responsible for managing the image data stored in the blog, resulting in unintentional image deletions.

### 2.Deleted Data:

Number of deleted images uploaded by users from "Image Management" function of the management screen in Livedoor Blog: 4,805 files

### 3.Duration of Incident:

Unknown - May 24, 2023

### 4.Sequence of events:

On June 2, 2023, the Company received a report from the contracted company stating the possibility of unintended file deletions occurring in the server that manages the blog's images. The Company conducted an internal investigation and recognized the potential loss of image data. The Company then contacted the contracted company to verify the details of the loss, backup status, identify the cause, and implement appropriate measures. On June 5, the Company received a detailed report from the contracted company regarding the loss of image data, identification of the cause, and actions taken. The Company has subsequently reported this incident to the relevant authorities.

### 5.Cause:

The loss of image data was caused by a malfunction in the program of the image data storage server that manages the images stored in the blog.

6.Current status:

The Company has already implemented measures to stop the program responsible for the issue in the image data management server, and no further incidents are expected.

7.Notice to users:

The Company will be contacting users who may have been affected by this incident sequentially.
