Notice Concerning Introduction of Internal Carbon Pricing System

Unipres Corporation (Head Office: Yokohama, Kanagawa; President: Nobuya Uranishi) gradually introduces an internal carbon pricing system (hereinafter referred to as “ICP System”) to group companies for Unipres group’s capital investment. An ICP System is a mechanism that enables companies to calculate the virtual cost of CO₂ emissions and aims to reduce the environmental impact of CO₂ emissions.

Under the management philosophy of “Achieve Sustainability Management”, the Unipres group aims for sustainable development together with society. As a part of its efforts to achieve carbon neutrality, Unipres has set the target of reducing CO₂ emission. Going forward, Unipres will strive to promote CO₂ reduction emissions by utilizing ICP System as a criterion for decisions about capital investment plans that entail a change in CO₂ emissions.

<Outline of ICP system by the Unipres group>

Internal carbon pricing fee : JPY18,000 per ton of CO₂

Scope : Capital investment entailing a change in CO₂ emissions

Method of application : The cost calculated by applying the internal carbon price with respect to changes in CO₂ emissions from the target investment shall be taken into account for making the capital investment decision.
