ENVIPRO HOLDINGS Inc. Receives CDP Score of "A-" for Climate Change Disclosure

The Company pleased to announce that we have received a score of "A-" for the year 2023 in the climate change survey conducted by CDP, an international non-profit organization.



CDP is a non-profit organization that operates the world's leading environmental disclosure platform. In 2023, more than 23,000 companies worldwide, including approximately 2,000 Japanese companies, disclosed information through CDP.

The Company has disclosed environmental information through the CDP since 2022, and in 2023, we responded to the Climate Change Questionnaire and received a score of "A-", the second highest rating out of nine. (Rated A to D-, F for non-responding companies)

The Company has been an early adopter of climate change-related issues, becoming the first company from the recycling industry to join the RE100 in 2018 and endorsing the TCFD recommendations in 2019.

In 2020, the Company decided to aim for practically zero GHG emissions from all of its operations by 2050, including the processing and recycling of scrap and waste handled by the Group, and in its medium-term management plan, which was released in 2023, the Company established and disclosed its GHG emissions reduction targets.

We will continue to promote various initiatives to solve environmental issues based on our strategic concept of "Lead a circular economy" with the mission of " Contribute to create a sustainable society" while focusing on harmony with the nature and coexistence with local communities.
