Notice Concerning the Setting of GHG Emission Reduction Targets

Keihanshin Building Co., Ltd. (the “Company”) previously set a greenhouse gas (GHG) emission reduction target for the medium-term leading up to 2030, and hereby announces that it has now established a new GHG emission reduction target for the long-term leading up to 2050.

1. Background to the Setting of a Long-term Target

The Company has been actively engaged in efforts to reduce GHG emissions through efforts such as using electricity from renewable energy sources in its office buildings since FYE March 2023, thereby steadily reducing emissions against its current GHG emission reduction target (to reduce Scope 1 and 2 GHG emissions by 46% by FYE March 2031, compared to FYE March 2020). Now, in order to further promote efforts to reduce GHG emissions, and to support the Japanese government’s goal to achieve carbon neutrality by 2050, the Company has decided to set a GHG emission reduction target for the long-term leading up to 2050.

2. The Company’s GHG Emission Reduction Target

Medium-term target:

Reduce Scope 1 and 2 GHG emissions by 46% by FYE March 2031, compared to FYE March 2020.

Long-term target:

Achieve net-zero GHG emissions (Scopes 1, 2, and 3) by FYE March 2051.

The Company recognizes that various sustainability efforts, including responding to climate change, have an impact on the Company’s sustainable growth and on improving its medium- to long-term corporate value. Going forward, the Company will continue to contribute to the realization of a sustainable society through its sustainability efforts.
